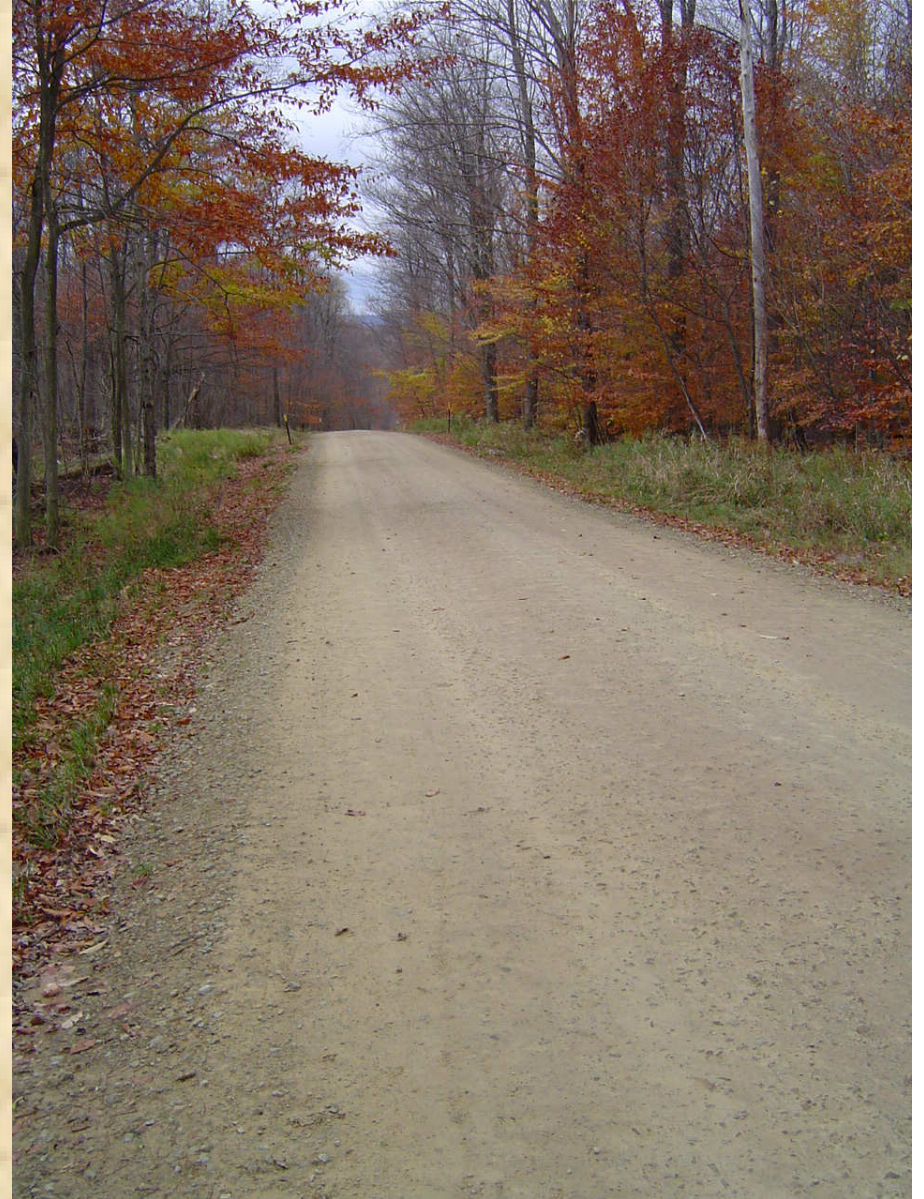

Program Accomplishments

- The Environmentally Sensitive Maintenance of Dirt and Gravel Roads Program in Sullivan County started in 1997
- Seven of the counties municipalities are currently eligible to receive funds through program.
- Since 1997, a total of 34 projects have been completed.
- A total of \$500,000.00 has been awarded to these projects.
- The district currently has an additional \$100,000.00 under contract on six projects.



Reassessment of our Roadways

- A complete review and reassessment of eligible roadways will begin in the summer of 2007.
- This will allow for a new look at eligible sites and potentially justify the increase for funding allocations.
- The district is looking to you for assistance in this.
