

Principles of Pruning Workshop

The Sullivan County Conservation District will offer a workshop on the Principles of Pruning. This workshop will be held on **Saturday, February 25, 2017** from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon at the Sullivan County Agricultural Resource Center outside of Dushore on State Route 487. This workshop will explore pruning of deciduous and evergreen trees and shrubs. Participants will obtain an understanding of why, when, and how a tree or shrub should be pruned. The program registration fee is \$20.00 per person. Due to limited class size, preregistration is required. Registration deadline is February 17.
