Deciduous

Sugar Maple – 12-18" seedlings, can grow to 75'. It does not do well in wet areas. Native, provides products from sap in the spring.

Red Oak – 12-18" seedlings, can grow to 75', fast growing, red to red brown leaves in Autumn.

White Oak – 12-18" seedlings, can grow to 90'. Will grow in wet areas, best in rich loamy soils, full sun. Resistant to ice breakage and oak wilt.

Evergreens

Norway Spruce – (2-0) 5-10" seedlings, can grow to 150', Good for Christmas trees, timber and windbreaks. Thrives in ordinary soils: needs good moisture to keep green color. Space 6' apart.

Fraser Fir – (3-0) 5-10" seedlings, can grow to 100'. Easy to care for. Very good as Christmas trees. Needs good drainage.

Scotch Pine – (2-0) 5-12" seedlings, can grow to 100' and should reach 6' in 8-9 years. Silvery blue needles. It likes most soils and average sun. It does not like wet soils. It is great for Christmas trees.

Semi-Dwarf Trees

Two-year tree pruned to a 1/2" to 7/8" branch, 5' high.
Most require two different varieties for proper pollination.

Apple Trees

Gala – Sweet, crisp yellow skin. Ripens in August. Good for eating and salads.

Melrose – Fruit is large, firm, crisp, and juicy. It finishes an attractive red on yellow background. Melrose keeps well in storage and is a premium cooking apple.

Smokehouse – Yellow, firm skin, crisp, spicy aromatic flavor. Ripens in September. Good for eating, salads, pies, and sauces.

Granny Smith – Green firm crisp flesh. Long storage life. Good baking apple.

Idared – Slightly tart and juicy. Ripens in October.

Plum Trees

Shiro – 2 YR budded, A sweet, juicy yellow plum. Fruit is round, clingstone and medium in size. The trees are spreading and very productive. Shiro is a good pollenizer for Methley, Santa Rosa and Satsuma.

Methley – 2 YR budded, An early plum with fine quality and appearance. The fruit is purple with red, sweet flesh and very juicy with a distinctive flavor. Ripening in early to mid-July, Methley is self-fertile and a good pollenizer for Shiro.

Blueberry Bushes

Thrive almost anywhere in acid soil; in alkaline soils, add aluminum sulfate. Plant two different varieties for best results. Like full sun.

Blue Jay – Ripen mid-season. 2 year-12". Medium light blue berries, hardy.

Elliott – Ripen late. Grows vigorously, large fruit. 2YR-12"

Grapes

Concord - Seedless, blue color. Tops for jams, juice, wine. Slightly smaller fruit. Ripens mid-September.

Reliance - A red seedless variety having a medium to large sized clusters of berries. Skin is tender and flesh has a melting texture with excellent flavor. Ripens 3 weeks prior to concord.

Strawberries

Seascape – Everbearing and cold hardy. Large, firm and flavorful berries.

Native/Wildlife/Stream Enhancement

American Redbud – 12-18" seedlings. Flowers are perfect reddish purple in bud opening to rosy, pink with purple tinge in springs. Very effective as a mass plant. Leaves 3-5" long and wide.

White Dogwood – 12-18" seedlings. Grows up to 30' tall. Dark green foliage turning scarlet red in the fall. Clusters of White flower blooms in May. Red cluster berries in the fall.

Tulip Poplar – 12-18" seedlings. Can grown to 150 ft. Rapid growth in light well drained soils. Very valuable hardwood timber.

River Birch – 12-18" seedlings The cinnamon-colored, exfoliating bark of the River Birch is spectacular in the winter. Lustrous, medium-green leaves. Tolerant to both wet soils and dry summers. Avoid very alkaline soils. Grows 40-70'.

American Elderberry – 12-18" seedlings. – Root Stock. It is a fast-growing shrub, grown for its clusters of bluish-black berries, which appear in late summer. It is great for jams and for wildlife.
